Bo Bishop

A 1991 graduate, Bo Bishop was a four year varsity letter winner in wrestling while earning two varsity letters each in the sports of football and track & field. On the wrestling mat is where Bo Bishop established himself as one of the premier members of Mason High School's wrestling program as he was the FAVC League and Sectional Runner Up during his sophomore season followed by 2 consecutive FAVC and Sectional championships during his junior and senior seasons. A 2-time OHSAA District Qualifier, Bo captured the District Championship during his senior year while qualifying to the OHSAA State Wrestling Meet. Bo accomplishments on the mat earned him accolades as a Western Star All Area selection during his sophomore, junior, and senior seasons as well as the Western Star's Co-Wrestler of the Year as a senior. At the time of graduation Bo held 3 school records in Takedowns (136), Wins in a Season (35) and Reversals (28).

Keri McGrath

Keri McGrath was one of the outstanding athletes in the class of 1994 earning a total of eight varsity letters in volleyball (3), Basketball (3), and Track & Field (2) during her high school career. Kerri was named a Fort Ancient Valley Conference 1st team All-Conference selection in the both volleyball and basketball during her junior and senior seasons while earning FAVC and Western Star Player of the Year honors in basketball during her senior year. Additionally, during her junior year Kerri was named a 1st Team Western Star All Area selection in volleyball and basketball while being named Honorable Mention to the Cincinnati Enquirer's All Area list in basketball during her junior and senior years. On the basketball court, Kerri was a member of 3 FAVC Championships teams in 1992, 1993, and a 1994 team that went undefeated in regular season competition.

Bob Highfill

A four year varsity letter winner on both the football field and the baseball diamond, Bob Highfill was a standout member of the 1997 graduating class. On the football field, Bob was named a Western Star 1st Team All-Area selection and a Cincinnati Post Honorable Mention selection as a junior. As a senior, Bob was named the Western Star Player of the Year in addition to being named an FAVC 1st Team All-Conference selection, 2nd team All-Area by the Cincinnati Enquirer and Cincinnati Post, 1st Team All-Southwest District and All-Ohio Special Mention. On the baseball diamond, Bob was named a Fort Ancient Valley Conference 1st Team All-Conference selection, Cincinnati Post 1st Team All-Area selection and a 2nd Team Western Star All-Area selection as a junior. During his senior campaign Bob was once again named an FAVC 1st Team All-Conference selection while being named Honorable Mention by the Cincinnati Enquirer.

Carla Kampschmidt

A four year participant in the sport of softball, Carla Kampschmidt graduated Mason High School as one of the most decorated athletes in the history of Mason Softball. Carla was named a Fort Ancient Valley Conference 1st Team All-Conference selection during her sophomore, junior and senior seasons earning FAVC Player of the Year honors at the conclusion of her senior season. Additionally, Carla was a 3-time Western Star Offensive Player of the Year selection. At the time of her graduation Carla held Mason career records in hits (121), doubles (24), runs batted in (72), and average (.465) while also owning a 40 game hitting streak dating back to April of her junior year. After graduating from Mason High School, Carla continued her softball career at Muskingum College where she earned Academic All-America honors and 3rd team All-America honors during her senior year while serving as a tri-captain on Muskingum College's 2001 National Championship Team.

Craig Adkins

A 1998 graduate, Craig Adkins excelled as a three year varsity participant both on the football field and the baseball diamond. In football, during his junior campaign

Craig was a Fort Ancient Valley Conference 1st Team All-Conference selection and a Western Star 1st Team All-Area selection. Additionally, Craig was named honorable mention All-City by the Cincinnati Post and All-Southwest Ohio while helping lead the Comets to an FAVC Championship and a spot in the OHSAA Regional Finals. During his senior year, Craig was named an FAVC 1st Team All-League selection, Western Star Offensive Player of the Year, and a Cincinnati Enquirer 1st Team All-City, All-Southwest Ohio, and All-State Honorable Mention selection. Craig participated in the East-West All Star Game and currently holds school records in scoring (162 points), Rushing Yards (1647), Rushing Touchdowns (22), Average Yards per Carry (9.0), and longest run (94 yards). On the baseball diamond during his senior season Craig was named the Western Star Offensive Player of the Year and participated in the East-West All Star Game. Craig led the team in 7 statistical categories, including stolen bases in a season (48), both a school record and 9th all-time in Ohio High School history.
